In view of the fact that universal fit lift truck buckets slip onto the forks directly, they stay on the machinery and are a lot less at risk to damage. These buckets are even 50 percent deeper as opposed to the quick-tach bucket models. This additional space makes them ideal for carrying irregular shaped loads like broken up concrete, backfilling behind walls, tearing off roof trash, elevating roof gravel and moving large debris piles.

Moreover, made as attachments used for extendable-reach forklifts, Quick-Tack buckets, are designed to allow the positioning of materials far beyond the normal reach of the loader. A hardened beveled cutting blade on both sides and on the leading edge reinforces strength, resistance to damage and provides supreme durability.
